



PeMSAA-UK Award for best published Quality Improvement Project/ Audit/ Research in Sri Lanka

PeMSAA UK is keen to encourage Peradeniya Medical Faculty qualified Trainees working as a non-Consultant grade Doctors in Sri Lanka to develop expertise in Projects and Research. The PeMSAA-UK Academic committee endeavours to endorse this by recognising the best Quality Improvement Project/ Audit/ Research published by a Trainee / non-Consultant grade Doctor.

The criteria for submission is as follows:

Any doctor **qualified from Peradeniya Medical School** and a **member of PeMSAA** or its local Chapter, holding a post as an intern house officer, senior house officer, medical officer, registrar, senior registrar, junior lecturer, or family practitioner is eligible to submit their project or research

- The applicant should be within 10 years of being graduated MBBS
- The submission should be a Quality Improvement Project, an Audit or Research carried out **within Sri Lanka**
- It should have been published in a recognised and reputable journal in Sri Lanka or abroad by the time of submission to PeMSAA-UK
- The submission must be published within the last **FIVE** years to qualify for consideration
- The submission could be in a basic medical subject, or any clinical or non-clinical (health management) medical speciality

Procedure of award:

- The published Quality Improvement Project/Audit/Research should be submitted to the President of PEMSAA UK in electronic format at Pemsaa.uk@gmail.com
- The electronic submission form (available at www.Pemsaa.uk website) **should** be duly completed and attached with the application for consideration
- **The last date for submission is 31 July 2020**
- The President of PeMSAA-UK in consultation with the members of the PeMSAA-UK Academic Committee will choose the recipient of the award
- The prize money will be Sri Lankan Rupees 100,000/=
- The final decision will be made within 2 months of closing date
- Only **ONE** award will be granted per each calendar year
- The award will be presented at an Annual PeMSAA event
- The winner of the Prize would be recommended to the PeMSAA Executive Committee for consideration for presentation of their worthy work at a PeMSAA event
- PeMSAA-UK will reserve the right to publish a summary of the winning entry and the profile of the winner in their website/annual brochure
