The Role of Microbiome in Health and Disease

By Professor Tim Spector

Professor of Genetic Epidemiology and Director of the
Twins UK Registry at Kings College, London.

Prof Spector will explore the role of the Microbiomes, the collective genomes of the microbes that live inside and on the human body, and the important role they play in health and many diseases including obesity, heart disease, diabetes, mental illness, etc, many of which previously thought to be mainly due to genes, ageing and environment. By conducting the largest scientific nutrition research project, he has found that the response to food and drugs shows great variation between people, even in identical twins, due to the role of the Microbiomes.
